Monitoring and documenting cases of stigma, discrimination and other human rights violation by holding a study among PLHIV and key populations in the field of HIV service.



Holding a social experiment which shall illustrate key manifestations of stigma and discrimination revealed and registered during monitoring



Advocating equal access to services for PLHIV and key populations to ensure sustainable HIV care continuum

A community-based study among PLHIV and key populations.



A social experiment on PLHIV stigma and discrimination.



Organizing a community-based conference with involvement of various stakeholders, including Ministry of Health representatives





KEY PROJECT ACHIEVEMENTS



For the first time in Armenia, the community-based study on discrimination cases was conducted.



For the first time, the communities organized large HIV conference, during which it was possible to discuss the issues of discrimination toward PLHIV and key populations.



Under the conference, the memorandum of understanding was elaborated which will allow to join efforts for effective implementation of HIV program.
